Response:

SECTION 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

SECTION 5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

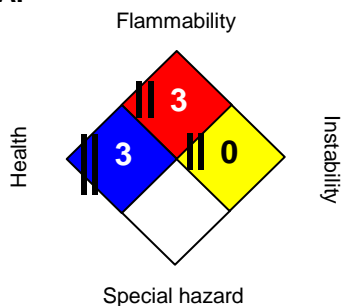
