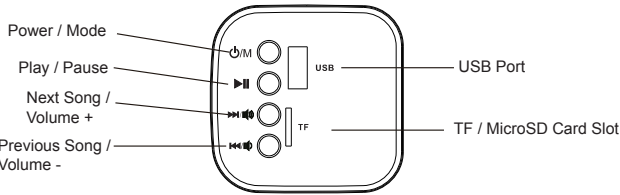

1. 3.5mm Stereo Aux Input
2. Optical Digital Input
3. AC Adapter Input

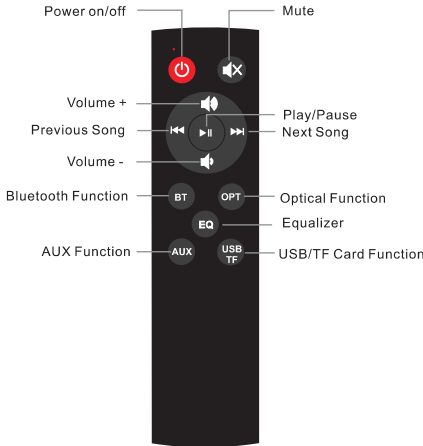
BUTTONS (SIDE PANEL)



- ⏻/M : Press & Hold for power on/off. Press and release to change input mode.
- ▶▶ : Press and release to play or pause music in Bluetooth, USB, or TF/MicroSD modes.
- ⏮/⏭ : Press & Hold for volume +. Press and release to change to next song.
- ⏮/⏭ : Press & Hold for volume -. Press and release to change to previous song.
- USB : USB Port supports MP3, WMA, and WAV audio files. Supports USB drives up to 32GB.
- TF : TF/MicroSD Card Slot supports MP3, WMA, and WAV audio files. Supports cards up to 32GB.

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Remote Control



- ⏻ : Press to power on/off.
- ⏻ : Press to mute/un-mute sound.
- ▶▶ : Press to play or pause music (Bluetooth and USB/TF modes only).
- ⏮/⏭ : Press to skip to the next song (Bluetooth and USB/TF modes only).
- ⏮/⏭ : Press to skip to the previous song (Bluetooth and USB/TF modes only).
- EQ : Press to change equalizer settings (Flat, Classical, Rock, Pop, Jazz, and Live).
- BT : Press to enter Bluetooth Mode.
- OPT : Press to enter Optical Mode.
- AUX : Press to enter Aux Mode (3.5mm Stereo Aux Input).
- USB/TF : Press to enter USB or TF Card Mode (device must be connected to enter mode).

INPUT FUNCTIONS

BLUETOOTH

To listen to music from a Bluetooth enabled device, you must first pair the device to the soundbar using the following steps:

1. Press the "BT" button on the remote, or press the "MODE" button on the side panel repeatedly until the soundbar enters Bluetooth mode.
2. Make sure the device you wish to pair (ex: smartphone, tablet, etc.) is in Bluetooth pairing/search mode (refer to the owners manual of your device for how to enter Bluetooth pairing/search mode).
3. On your device, perform a Bluetooth "device discovery" to add the soundbar as a new device.
4. When the soundbar is discovered your device will show "ESB2229" in the device list. Tap/Select "ESB2229" to pair the soundbar to your device.
5. If you are asked to enter a password, please enter "0000".

Once pairing is successful, you can play music directly from your device through the soundbar. The music can be controlled either directly on your device, or by using the Play/Pause, Next/Previous buttons on the soundbar or on the remote.

AUX Input

1. Connect your external device (TV, DVD player, etc.) to the AUX Input using the supplied 3.5mm stereo audio cable.
2. Press the "AUX" button on the remote, or press the "MODE" button on the side panel repeatedly until the soundbar enters Aux mode.
3. Control the playback from your connected external device (TV, DVD player) using the remote control from your device.
4. Volume can be controlled using the Volume +/- buttons on the remote or side panel.

OPTICAL Input (Preferred connection for best audio quality)

1. Connect your external device (TV, DVD player, etc.) to the Optical Input using a standard optical digital audio cable (not included).
2. Press the "OPT" button on the remote, or press the "MODE" button on the side panel repeatedly until the soundbar enters Optical mode.
3. Control the playback from your connected external device (TV, DVD player) using the remote control from your device.
4. Volume can be controlled using the Volume +/- buttons on the remote or side panel.

Note: If the soundbar is On but there is no sound output while in Optical mode, you may need to activate the PCM output setting on your source device (ex: TV, DVD player, etc.). Refer to the instruction manual of your device for instructions on activating PCM output.

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USB and TF/microSD Card Inputs

To listen to music from a USB flash drive or TF/microSD card, simply insert the USB drive, or card into the USB Port or TF/microSD card slot on the side panel. The soundbar will switch to the USB or TF card mode and immediately begin playing music from the drive/card.

- Supports MP3, WMA, and WAV audio files.
- Supports drives/cards up to 32GB.
- USB and TF card modes cannot be entered if there is no USB drive or TF/microSD card inserted in the soundbar.

LIMITED 90-DAY WARRANTY

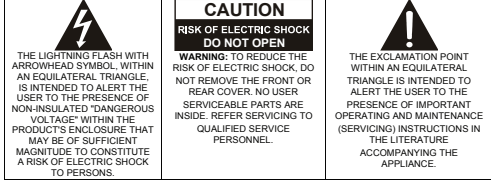
